Writing	We continued our Personal Narrative unit (true stories about us). We continued drafting our stories. We learned how to write leads (openings) to our stories to “hook” our readers in! We wrote Autumn acrostic poems.
Reading	We continued reading the book “The Wild Robot.” We reviewed how to visualize the setting of a story. We retold the story and made predictions. We learned new vocabulary words. We learned how to write a “stop-and-jot” to retell stories we read.
Math	We calculated elapsed time and began our year-long length-of-day project. We compared masses and divided wholes and sets into equal shares. We estimated and measured masses of objects.
Science	We learned more about the scientific method! We asked questions about the world around us. We conducted the “bag of water and pencil experiment.” We tested our hypotheses to see if they were true!
Handwriting	We finished reviewing and practicing proper letter formation (printing). We will begin learning cursive next week!
