




 <p><b>Card 1:</b> At about 24 hours after planting, the embryonic root emerges.</p>	 <p><b>Card 2:</b> After about 28 hours, the seedling emerges from the potting mix. The seed coat is split, and the white cotyledons or seed leaves are visible.</p>	 <p><b>Card 3:</b> During Day 2 and 3, both the root system and the cotyledons, which are now green, continue to grow.</p>
 <p><b>Card 4:</b> On Day 4 or 5, the first true leaves appear at the growing tip of the plant, between the seed leaves.</p>	 <p><b>Card 5:</b> From Days 4 through 7, the true leaves continue to emerge and grow at a remarkably rapid pace.</p>	 <p><b>Card 6:</b> By Day 8 or 9, the yellow-green flower buds appear in a tight cluster.</p>
